I am on the battlefield for my Lord.

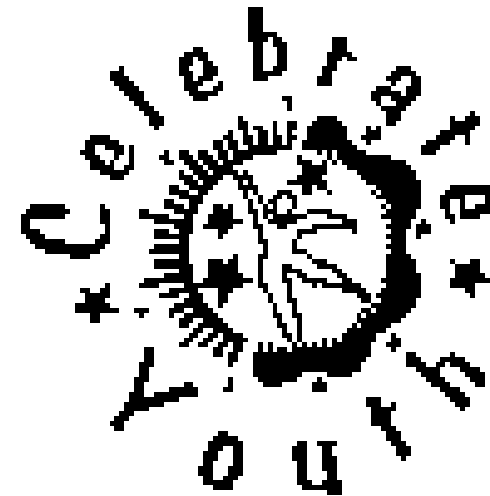
Verse 3

Dr. Zee Anderson Barron's religious affiliations include: National Director of the Young People's Department of the National Baptist Convention U.S.A. Inc; Vice Chair of the Board; and Program Director of the National Baptist Youth Camp in Constantine, Michigan; member of the publication "The Light," a devotional magazine for Junior Missionary Societies. Additionally, "The Light" served as a handbook and study guide for the Christian Young people. It also provided program suggestions for the Junior Missionary Socialites. *Dr. Barron* spent most of her adult life making things better for the young people in the church.
