State Thematic Drama

General Description

The Thematic Drama is designed to give a visualization of the Conference theme, bring the scriptures to life. Young people have an opportunity to express their acting talent as well as their skills in producing a Biblical drama. This will require them to do in-depth Bible Study and research in order to produce the drama. The drama must be based on the theme which is "SOLIDARITY WITH THE SAVIOR THROUGH HIS WORSHIP" John 4:23-24; PSALM 27:4; PHILIPPIANS 3:3, and REVELATIONS 19:10. The drama can come from any story in the Bible, which will reflect this theme. Each state director should submit to Rev. Henry Coleman.

Rules Governing the Event

- 1. Each State Convention can enter one drama in this competition.
- 2. You will have two (2) minutes set-up time.
- 3. You will have eight (8) minutes performance time.
- 4. You must provide all your own props and materials
- 5. At the end of the eight minutes, the presentation will be stopped.
- 6. A performance, which goes over time, will be penalized five (5) points.
- 7. All materials must be removed from the stage immediately to prepare for the next performance.

Age Categories

All ages can participate in this event. Participants must be from your state convention and registered at the conference.

Judging Criteria

- 100 Interpretation of the Theme (How well the drama interprets the theme and scriptures)
- 100 Creativity (How creative is the drama in terms of props, sounds, lights, music, etc.)
- 100 Costumes (Are costumes appropriate, tasteful, coordinated, well chosen, etc.

The winner will receive a trophy. Categories are as follows:

- Outstanding Theme Interpretation
- Outstanding Creativity
- Outstanding Costumes
