Perhaps you are not yet sure about what Zion and our sister churches stand for, or perhaps you have not yet received baptism. Still, we are truly glad to be with you today, and you are invited to fold your hands over your chest to indicate that you are receiving a blessing instead, but please talk with our pastor or with one of our elders after worship so that indeed we may receive this precious gift from Jesus together soon.

The clear cups in the center of the trays indeed contain a drop of wine that is then diluted with grape juice. Alternatively, anyone who needs to abstain entirely from alcohol may receive only the Body of Christ at this time.
