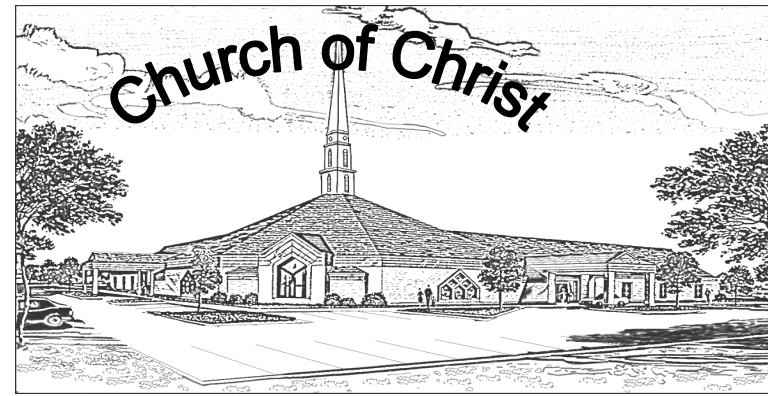

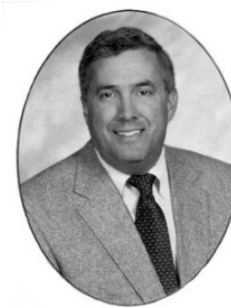

Make no mistake about it; vacation season is in full swing.



Our attendance and contribution numbers testify to it. Don't get me wrong, I am a firm believer in the need to take a vacation now and then. Everybody needs a break from the routine and some time off to recoup physically and emotionally from the wears and tears of day to day life. Jesus knew this and saw this need even within his own disciples. The gospel of Mark gives us his insight into how the toll of day to day ministry had on his disciples and how he recognized their need to get away. "Then, because so many people were coming and

going that they did not even have a chance to eat, he said to them, "Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest" (6:31).

While vacations provide us with a much needed break from the norm, there is one place where we cannot afford to take a vacation...and that is from God. We should never allow vacations to cause us to break from our responsibilities as a follower of Jesus. Unfortunately, for some they allow their vacation itinerary to take precedent over taking time out to worship God. There is also the tendency to allow the vacation budget to take away from their normal contribution to the Lord's work at home. Even ones normal habit of spending time with God in His word and talking to God through prayer often falls by the wayside during this break from the routine.

So let me encourage all of us when we do make time for a break from the routine to refresh the mind and body, not to neglect our spiritual responsibilities. We can use this special time to expand our awareness of God's family as we visit other congregations. It can also provide us with some special time and places to encounter God in our private devotions. You see, it doesn't have to be and either/or dilemma. With some forethought and discipline, we can use our vacations as a time to refresh our mind, body, and soul.
