We are diving into the Old Testament book of Exodus. The entire book carries the theme of Redemption following the Fall that occurred in Genesis. Four hundred years have transpired since the final chapter of Genesis. In that time, God has been preparing the land for the Jews and the Jews for the land. The people groups who are dwelling in the Promised Land are exceedingly wicked. God, in His abundant mercy, has given them 400 years to repent.

Meanwhile, God has preserved and grown the Jews as a group of strangers among the Egyptians. They are challenged to live like the worldly Egyptian, yet learn to live according to God's will in the hostile land. We met Moses and his courageous parents who obeyed the letter of the law but not the spirit and in doing so, saved the life of a baby with a big future!

We will follow Moses as he leads God's people out of Egyptian slavery and into the Promised Land. And although God took the slaves out of Egypt, He now must take the Egypt out of the slaves. They will learn to walk by faith in very real and tangible ways. He will reveal His law to them His plans for their future.

We will learn, through the story of the Exodus, to trust God as well. We will learn to experience His redemption.
