

## The Red Zone

If you stay on this track, the Bible warns you will never experience life as God intended and your separation from God will last for all eternity. If you desire to move out of this zone, you must begin by coming to Christ and acknowledging your need and asking for His forgiveness. If you already are a Christ-follower, perhaps rededicating your life to Him anew will provide a fresh start for you in your spiritual journey with Christ. ## The Yellow Zone

If you find yourself here, you must begin with Christ. He must be the source of the life you want to have.

## The Green Zone

Your journey with Christ seems to be on track! You need to keep growing. The track you're on is a great one, but it's important that you not become weary or indifferent. Continue in the patterns and practices that have brought you this far.

# How to be Sure You're a Christian

Clarity about your spiritual condition is one of the most important issues in life. God wants you to know where you stand with Him. If you have not yet committed your life to Christ, it's important to be clear on that as well.

The writers of Scripture teach that it is possible to be deceived about our spiritual condition—it is possible to have false confidence. It is also possible to have undue anxiety when, in reality, God offers wonderful promise of assurance.

This tool is designed to help you gain an accurate picture of your spiritual condition. As you answer these questions, be completely honest (so that the results are valid).



# How to Be SURE You're a Christian

NOTE: Scoring is on a one-to-five scale. One means "Rarely or never true of me". Three means "Sometimes describes me". Five means "Completely true of me".

## Gratitude for What Christ Has Done

1. I put my complete trust in Jesus' death and resurrection for my salvation; I've received forgiveness of sin based on His provision, not on my behavior. 1 2 3 4 5
2. I find myself moved and grateful when I think of what he did for me on the cross. 1 2 3 4 5
3. I express my gratitude regularly through activities such as prayer, corporate and private worship, and observing Communion. 1 2 3 4 5

## Telling Others My Story
