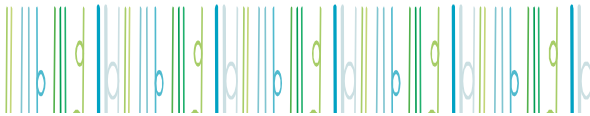


Recovery Ministry

Making Peace With Your Past

MPWP is a nondenominational, faith-based support/recovery ministry. When offered, this program meets on Monday night for 12 weeks. MPWP is an entry-level opportunity to begin one's healing journey with information, tools, and the experience of healing in a small group community setting from issues arising from one's family-of-origin. MPWP began at Westview in 2003 and involves at least 10 leaders and approximately 25 to 30 participants. Upon completion, the next step in one's healing journey after MPWP is the Living Waters Ministry. These two programs are alternately offered each year.

Living Waters

The goal of Living Waters is to lay a foundation for sexual and relational wholeness in our lives. Living Waters is an in-depth, Christ-centered program for people seeking healing in areas of sexual and relational brokenness (28 week program).

Women's Support Group

This Oasis group meets weekly in the evenings. The only cost involved is the cost for study materials. Oasis support group is for women who have experienced losses.

This support group is led by people who understand what you are going through and want to help. You will gain access to Divorce Care resources to help you deal with issues of your past and look forward to rebuilding your future.
