SERVE WEEK 2013

WHO: All youth (completed 7th-12th grade)

WHEN: June 30—July 4

WHERE: Waco, TX

COST: \$100 per person (includes all meals, t-shirt, lodging)

HOUSING: Mission Waco Dormitory

WHAT TO BRING: Sleeping bag or twin sheets/blanket, pillow, towels, soap, toiletries, refillable water bottle, t-shirts, shorts (appropriate length), tennis shoes, a pair of jeans, one nicer shirt for church service, work clothes (could be painting, yard work, sorting clothes...), work gloves, spending money is optional

WHAT NOT TO BRING: No tank tops or spaghetti strap tops, revealing or tight clothing, shorts that are shorter than mid-thigh, or clothing with inappropriate messages, valuable items: jewelry, electronic equipment, individual music w/ headphones, computer games, drugs, alcohol, weapons.*

*If any discipline issues arise or if any of these items are found in the possession of a teenager, they will be sent home, at their parents expense



MISSION WACO: Mission Waco began in 1978 with Jimmy and Janet Dorrell being called to live among the poor and help bring the “good news” through relationships and empowerment opportunities. Mission Waco’s programs were built around three goals: **1)** relationship-based, holistic programs among the poor and marginalized, **2)** mobilizing middle-class Christians toward “hands-on” involvement, and **3)** addressing some of the systemic issues which disempowered the poor. As volunteers, interns, and donations increased, and as local gaps were identified, additional programs were added to the existing children and teen programs. Today, there are some fifteen programs for all ages and a staff of twenty five persons. A board of twenty Christian men and women from different churches oversee the direction.

WHAT ARE WE GOING TO BE DOING? We will be doing service projects in the morning and leading a street camp in the afternoon. We will also lead a Chapel service one night and other things needed from Mission Waco.
