## WHAT TO BRING

(Remember, it will be HOT!)

- Bible and pen
- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Swimsuit (modest 1-piece for girls; no Speedos for guys) & towel
- Toiletries & flashlight
- Sunscreen (it'll be in the 90s)
- Water bottle
- Sunglasses
- Tennis shoes & shoes for water sports
- Jacket or sweatshirt
- Money for 2 lunches (on the way to and from camp), for the Snack Shack @ Coram, & 8 quarters for showers.
- Prescription medications in their original bottle (see Medical Policy)
- A good attitude and willingness to comply with your leader
- Dress code clothing (We ask that you wear modest clothing. You will be asked to change your clothes if they are too revealing.)

## DON'T BRING

## DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Daroga State Park is located 18 miles north of East Wenatchee, Washington, on the east side of the Columbia River.

### **Directions from East Wenatchee:**

From the south, drive 18 miles north on Hwy. 97. Be on the east side of the Columbia River. Pass Lincoln Rock State Park on your way.
