### Pastor's Page

Dear Friends,

I am so excited because we are into March and winter is almost over!!! I have really been thinking about spring and being outside and grass turning green and plants beginning to bud, and all that stuff. My thoughts of spring always seem to turn to Lent and Easter, because spring is the season of new beginnings. And Lent is right around the corner, beginning on Wednesday, March 9, with Ash Wednesday. We will worship together on Wednesday, march 9, at 7 pm, with an imposition of ashes being part of the service. We will then have our regular Wednesday Lenten services each week following, with a meal being served at 6:15 on Wednesday, March 16, March 30, and April 13, with worship at 7pm. The other Wednesday's, March 23, and April 6, we will have bars and coffee and worship at 7 pm.

We will also hold Lenten activities on Sunday nights, similar to what we did during Advent, gathering on Sunday evenings for a meal, worship/Spirituality activities, and Bible Study. These activities will begin at 6:30 and will be open to all.

The confirmation class will continue through Lent, culminating with the communicants joining the church on Easter Sunday. Please pray for our class, Zach Murphy and Nick and Kelsey Schmith as they continue their study. And, we are beginning a new adult Sunday School class on March 6 which will focus on our Presbyterian heritage, beliefs and history. The class will meet in the Meditation Room at 9 am and will run through Lent. I will be leading it.

Lent is a time for reflection on who we are and whose we are. It is the season for preparation for the blessed Easter event, but it is not a time to punish one's self, it is a time to look at our lives of faith to see where we are lacking, and to make changes to our lives. It is a time for deep reflection on who Jesus Christ is in our lives and the distances we place between Jesus and ourselves. In Lent, Jesus invites us to examine our situations, then do something about them. Worship, prayer, Bible study, meditation and reading, serving, these are all wonderful spiritual disciplines to begin during Lent, if they are lacking in one's life now. If you choose to "give up" something for Lent, that is your choice to make, but maybe we can look at "giving up" some of those behaviors we cling to that keep us from knowing fully the joy of discipleship in Christ. I would encourage each of us to truly look at one aspect of our faith lives and try to make some changes. Let us journey through this season of reflection and examination together, and not look past the grace offered us in Lent, in a rush to get to Easter. We have to go through Good Friday to get to Easter Sunday. Grace and Peace to you all.




