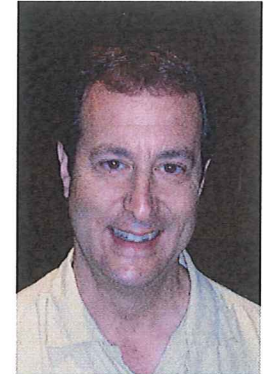


Tommie is a substitute teacher in Rye, NY who has been a Christian for over 30 years.

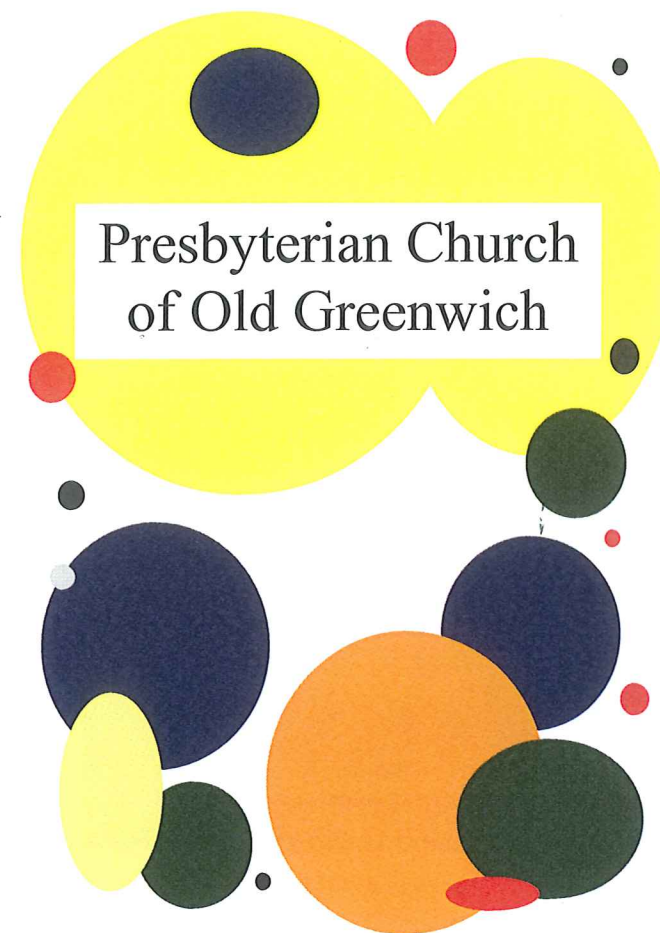
