Read This First

## Read John 17:3

Think about everything you know about the Christmas story and why God sent Jesus. There are so many funny versions and additions to the song "Jingle Bells." Why don't you try to make one about God giving us His only son and what we get if we just believe? It could be serious, funny or a little bit of both. You could write it alone or with family and friends.

Day 1

## Read 2 Corinthians 9:15

God must have thought we were pretty special to give us such an incredible gift like Jesus! Get wrapped up in that! When we follow God's example of generosity by sharing Jesus with others, we're giving someone a priceless gift.

Tape a few sheets of paper together and decorate them with drawings or with your favorite pictures from magazines or newspaper comics. Then use your new wrapping paper to wrap a small gift for someone! If they ask you what the special wrapping paper is for, tell them because God is generous, you want to be generous too.

**Ask** God to give you a chance to show His generosity to someone else.

## Day 2

### Read Isaiah 9:6.

Big things can come in small packages. Even though Jesus came as a baby in a manger, He was still the King of Kings.

On strips of paper, write six words or phrases that describe Jesus. Use words from today's verse and add more of your own. Create loops and then tape the strips together to form the shape of a Christmas tree. If you'd like, keep adding strips to the bottom to make the tree bigger.

**Talk** to Jesus using some of the names that describe Him.

## Day 3

### Read Luke 6:38.

Pour yourself a glass of water near the sink. Fill it to the brim so that it's overflowing then take a big drink.

We have a God who overflows with generosity. Think about it: God gave the biggest gift of all when He gave us Jesus. He wants us to give to others that way, too. We don't give in order to get something back. That's not how generosity works. However, God does say He'll bless us when we follow His example of giving big to others.

**Ask** God to help you overflow with generosity today.
