- 1. In what ways do you see the world being blessed through God's people? In other words, how is the church positively affecting the world around it?
- 2. Paul ways we have been given a ministry of reconciliation. In your opinion, what does that mean?
- 3. As ambassadors of Christ, we (the church) represent his character and desires to the world around us. In what ways are we representing him well? In what areas must we improve?

- 1. As you read 1 Corinthians 13, make two lists. What are the characteristics of love in the positive sense (all that love is). What characteristics does love not have?
- 2. Do you love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength? How would you describe the amount of love you show for others? Are you satisfied with your answers?
- 3. Put into your own words what happened in the shift from the Great Commandment of the Old Testament to the new commandment of Jesus.
- 4. After Paul listed all the qualities of the fruit of the Spirit, why did he then write, "Against such things there is no law"?
- 5. As you read the story from 1 Samuel 19, write down the ways that Jonathan offered David unconditional and sacrificial love.

Key Verse: "This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us." (1 John 4:10-12 **Key Idea:** I am committed to loving God and loving others.
