

Rwanda Update

(October 30, 2011) Muraho Redeemer! Thanks to the continued generous support from the folks at Redeemer, each quarter we are able to send our sister church in Kibungo, Rwanda a financial contribution to help sustain and grow the ministries in their diocese. The last contribution was for \$14,000 and enabled them to do the following: buy equipment for their boys and girls club, put a new roof on a primary school, support the ministries of four parishes, contribute to the Association of Anglican Students at the university, cover the burial costs of one of the pastors, purchase health insurance for returning refugees, repair the diocesan vehicle after a recent accident, and support the operating budget for St. Peter's Cathedral. It is truly exciting that we as a church are involved in furthering the gospel and building disciples both here and abroad. Thanks so much for your generosity!

Please pray that the right man will be chosen for the job: one who has a heart for Christ, strong leadership abilities, and a vision for the future.
