## Baby Bottle Boomerang Campaign



It is recorded in Luke 21:1-4, Jesus was watching at the Temple, as people were giving their offering. His attention turned to a poor widow who dropped in two mites. He pointed out, to the crowd, the value of her offering was greater than the wealthy donor's. In the eyes of man, what she deposited into the bucket was minuscule. To Jesus, it greatly outweighed the contribution of the rich because He knew her heart and the magnitude of her sacrifice. This little lady became infamous, and her story has been used to illustrate how God's power blesses the heart behind a donation.

The Baby Bottle Boomerang Campaign is a perfect example of The Widow's Mite. God uses bottles, full of change, to save lives and strengthen families. We are blessed with faithful churches who distribute bottles every year and return them filled with heartfelt gifts. Sometimes we find a note inside, or donation given in honor of a child who has gone on to be with Jesus. I (personally) have opened a bottle with as little as 35 cents in it. I have also pulled out checks valuing \$50, \$100 and more. We operate three centers, in three different counties, on less than \$130,000 per year. The Baby Bottle Campaign accounts for \$20,000 of that operation budget. It doesn't matter how well your financial capabilities are, this is a fundraising event where (literally) every penny counts. God accepts the Widow's Mite, and in His hands, it becomes the Widow's MIGHT!

If your church or organization doesn't participate in this powerful effort, or has not had a campaign in over a year, ask a member in leadership and please contact our office for more information on how you can help our Baby Bottle Campaign continue to be a success. There are almost 80 churches anticipated to participate in 2017. I would like to have 100 churches raise \$30,000 in 2018. She will continue to serve there and graciously assist us until we are able to obtain the sponsorship needed to hire a part time nurse manager for VOH. We are delighted to add her to our team.

Be in prayer, as we believe, SOON, there will be ultrasound capabilities added to Voice of Hope's Crawford & Wyandot County locations. God is building this ministry and we know He will send us the partners and team members needed.

## Sponsorship - Opportunities to partner with Voice of Hope

**Corporate/ Church Sponsorship-** Business & Church partners (listed on back of newsletter) underwrite the cost of fundraising. Thus, allowing 100% of the money, raised at our events, to go directly to the ministry. In exchange, we have an advertisement packet promoting each businesses and church. **Sonographer Sponsorship-** 80% of women facing an unplanned pregnancy, who are unsure, will choose life if given the opportunity to see and hear their baby. In order for this ministry to provide proper medical professionals to operate our clinic and capture the heartbeat and images of the baby, we needed to hire a nurse sonographer. The cost is \$100 per day and we schedule scans once a month. To be more available for women facing a crisis pregnancy and cover the expense, we need, at least, 4 sponsors to commit to pay for one day a month. If you would like to become a Sonographer Sponsor and help us provide a voice for the voiceless, please contact our office for more information.

**Monthly Donors-** VOH depends on consistent support of monthly donors. This contribution commitment can range from any amount. We have donors that give \$5 - \$500 per month. As in every home, and organization, it takes money to keep the roof overhead, and power behind the flip of the light switch. It helps our office manager to know how much money to expect each month as she prepares to pay the bills and purchase things needed around the centers.
