

### The New Abortion Profile



In the work we do to preserve the lives of unborn babies, a sort of profile has emerged of what we expect our clientele or their circumstances for seeking abortion to be. However, that profile was recently blown out of the water for me. The situation I want to share with you is important in two ways. First, and most importantly, you need to see the far reaching scope of your support. Second, this example speaks volumes to the kind of world in which we live. I came into the center on a Friday expecting our usual type of client. However, when I met the folks who came to us for support, it was an entire family! The mother and father were living together as a family with two children: one about 7 years old, one almost 1 year old, and one unplanned on the way. Both of these parents worked. The father has worked for a temporary service for multiple years, at the same local factory and has never been put on direct employment there. His attendance was perfect. In fact when he came into the center his next stop was work. Being employed by the factory would take him off the temporary service at \$9.50 an hour and raise him to \$18.75 an hour; a dramatic difference. His wife worked at a local fast food chain. They received no public assistance and didn't want any. He was proud that he was able to take care of his family,

but he wanted her to have an abortion because they simply could not take care of another child. I could see the heart of this man and it broke my own. He lovingly introduced me to his children. His son was well behaved and their daughter was quiet and sweet. He bragged on them as any of us would. The Lord moved me to just do the ultrasound. I did and when he saw the baby he began to tear up. When we were done, I decided to talk to him about possibilities. We discussed the possibility of getting hired in at the factory at the fair wage and suggested how to approach that topic with his HR department. Most importantly, we discussed the possibilities that would be missed for his unborn baby. He or she could hold so many possibilities that could help all of mankind. Life is always a gift. Perhaps the timing isn't the greatest; but the reward is surely worth the undertaking. I talked to him about getting some counseling and taking advantage of the "Earn While You Learn" program at our center, that are so beautifully explained by our staff and volunteers. I prayed for them and reminded them that God WILL make a way where there seems to be no way. I offered my advocate services and told them they could call me if they had questions or needed more direction for services. They came into our office thinking they had an impossible choice to make; after the ultrasound, they signed up for our program and left filled with possibilities. Your work, your support, your encouragement can take the impossible and make it possible. For these unborn children we pray, and for you we give thanks.
