DAVID A. JEFFERS

David Jeffers was born on Christmas Day 1967 to a young woman who had experienced a classic "crisis pregnancy." Even by today's standards terminating the pregnancy may have been excused in the situation she found herself in, even by many who claim to be pro-life. Instead she chose to give the baby "life and hope" that a loving family would someday adopt and love the child. That's exactly what happened. As a very young infant David was adopted into a loving Christian family. They raised him along with his four other adopted siblings to be not just good productive adults but people who also cared tremendously for others and the values that this world has seemed to let slip by so easily. David had a happy, healthy childhood and made many friends easily. He was the easy-going, athletic, cool guy that everyone wanted to be friends with. He was the "protector" who looked out for others who perhaps could not stand up for themselves. He learned quickly and did well in school.

David became my stepfather 20 years ago. My memories of David are of a kind, gentle "giant" sort of easy going man who would do anything for anyone, never expecting anything in return. He worked hard every day to provide for the family. He loved my mother passionately. His love for the grandchildren was heartwarming and easily expressed. He was often quiet but had a quick smile and a deep robust laugh. If you could use one word to describe my personal view of David it would have to be "heroic." He put himself in harm's way several times that I know of over the years to help or protect someone else. He was one of the people I always knew I could count on if I needed him-and he was always there for us without hesitation. {Pg 2}

They had a baby shower for our Boutique and supplied us with many great and useful gifts. Blessings for all you did for VoH.

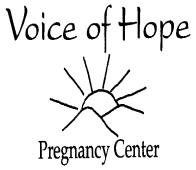
MOHAWK ECONOMICS STUDENTS
