## Specifics for Phases One and Two. Face Masks ARE Required For Attendance in Phase One

- 1. There will be two services on Sunday morning.
  - 9:00 am specifically for those who are over 60 years of age, the age considered at higher risk.
  - · 11:00 am for all worshippers under the age of 60.
- 3. Stream services will continue for those who prefer not to attend at this time.
- **4.** Sanctuary doors will be propped open when entering and existing.
- **5.** People from the same household will sit together in Sanctuary.
- **6.** All worshippers will maintain Social Distancing of at least 6 feet.
- 7. Asking all attendees who have underlying at-risk health conditions to stay home and watch services online.
  - · Risks to include but not limited to fever, colds, low immunity, illness of any nature, exposer to CoVid-19.
  - · Everyone is encouraged to be cautious and determine if it is safe for them to attend services at this time.
- **8.** There will be No Children's Ministry until schools **and/or** daycares are released to reopen. We will continue on-line ministry.
- 9. No Student Ministries until schools and/or daycares are released to reopen. We will continue online ministry.
- **10.** There will be no Adult Connection Groups until Announced. Continue online ministry.
  - · Classes will be scheduled under Dr. Darlington's Supervision.
- **11.** All ancillary ministries are suspended until announced.
- **12.** Musicians and Praise Team will lead worship with rotation of members. Choir is suspended through **Phase 1&2.**

- **13.** Hand Sanitizers will be available.
- **14.** No weekly planners or other material passed out. All announcements will be communicated through the sanctuary media and social media.
- **15.** Stewardship will be encouraged to be through on-line giving.
- **16.** Offering will be received at end of service as people leave the sanctuary placing their offing in the plate.
- **17.** Congregation will be dismissed by rows at the conclusion of the service. Worship will continue while people are existing the church.
- **18.** People will be asked to proceed immediately to their vehicles.
- 19. All Public door handles will be disinfected before and between services.
- 20. Restrooms cleaned and disinfected in between services.
- 21. Wednesday night Hour of Power Prayer will continue at 6:00 PM via online ZOOM.
