Prices are \$8 or 2 for \$15 for 6 cake pops in a decorative container.

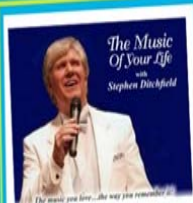


