A Note From Drew...

As we enter a new year, it is a good time to evaluate where we are, individually and as a church. During the month of January, I am going to be preaching a series of messages in which I am going to challenge all of us to take the next step, to jump right in, to make some specific commitments as Christ-followers. I want to encourage you to look at your priorities,

to examine your life and to see where you need to grow or change. Let's be honest as we evaluate our lives.

As we look at the church, I would like to share a few observations with you. There are several indicators that I look at that tell me about the health of the church — things like faithfulness, unity, growth, attendance, attitude, and giving. While we are going well in almost all of those areas, there are two that concern me, growth and attendance. While we have big numbers, those numbers are not increasing. We are running around 1,100 every Sunday, which was good three years ago, but not now.

Now I know that some might think I am just interested in numbers, but remember, each number represents a soul that is either going to heaven or to hell. So talking about numbers is just a way of measuring if we are adding new people to the Kingdom. Remember they counted numbers in the book of Acts. Why is our attendance not increasing? We have identified several areas; one, we are not doing as good a job as we should in following up on visitors and new people. Another is that we are not investing enough time in shepherding the people who are members, and another is our shortage of parking and seating during the second service.

To help with following up on new people, we have begun a program that Dale DeNeal, Sue Dowdy, and Phil Johnson have worked very hard on called CARDIO. To help with shepherding issues, we continue to encourage our Adult Bible Fellowships and Life Groups to care for their members, and we are recruiting and equipping more people to be involved in shepherding. To help with the parking situation, we are going to expand our parking lot this spring.

But what are we going to do about the second service being full? New people will not keep coming if they have to sit on the front row (some of you who are members might move there now). When you reach 80% of capacity, it will begin to impact growth. Since the 9:30 service is the prime time for attendance, we are discussing, adding a fourth service on Sunday morning. The Elders and staff have been talking about options for over a year and this seems to be the most workable. We have met with one group of ministry leaders to discuss the four service format and have another meeting scheduled that is open to everyone on January 14th. We are looking at this time schedule for the services-7:45-8:45, 9:00-10:00, 10:15-11:15, and 11:30-12:30. What we are hoping this will do is encourage you second service people to choose between the two middle services, thus providing us with more seating without the expense of building. Again, please understand that our desire here is to reach people for Jesus Christ and to help each person who comes here grow into a fully devoted follower of Christ.

Here is what I would like you to do; pray for wisdom as we plan for the future and for growth, get excited about another move that promotes the Kingdom, join me on January 14th at 6:30 for a "town hall" discussion about this four service format, and look for ways to work together and to encourage each other in seeking and doing God's will.

With the new year, we are continuing to emphasize reading the Bible. I hope you will join me as we read God's love letter to us together. Get your Bible reading program and take part in this vital, life-changing experience.

Remember, if you need to talk or if you need help in your next step in following Christ, I am available. Please call the office and I will set up an appointment with you. Let's make 2010 a year of growth both individually and as a church.

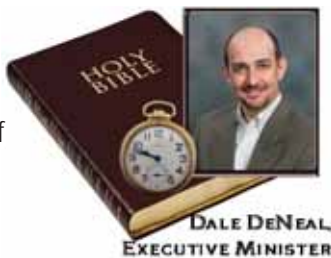
Self-Discipline

TIME IN THE WORD

There are five facets to spending time in God's word: hearing, reading, studying, memorizing, and meditating. Each month I am focusing attention on one of the five facets. Last month I wrote about the discipline of hearing God's Word. For the month of January the focus is on reading God's Word.

How often should I read God's word? The Bible says you should read it daily. Deuteronomy 17:19 says, "The Scriptures shall be his constant companion. He must read from it everyday of his life so that he will learn to respect the Lord, his God, by obeying all of his commands" (Living Bible)." God wants us to read the Word of God on a daily basis.

Daily Bible reading works best if you have a goal and a plan. One of the most popular goals for reading the Bible is probably the read through the Bible in a year goal. This goal only requires about 20 minutes a day. A similar goal is to read through the New Testament in a year which is easier yet. Either of these goals is great, and with 2010 just around the corner, this is a perfect time to set a Bible reading goal for the New Year. However, goals are only as good as your plan – as the old adage goes, "He who fails to plan, plans to fail!" This brings us to the next item of discussion.



Bible reading plans are numerous and abundant. First, there are Bibles you can purchase that are specifically designed to help you read through the Bible in a year. Second, there are guides that fit in your Bible that list assigned reading for each day. Most of these come with a check box so you can keep track of your daily progress. Third, there are many internet tools that help you keep up with daily assignments. One example of an

online Bible reading tool is www.oneyearbibleonline.com. This website has many different plans as well as Bible translations to choose from. Some internet tools will send you a daily e-mail (www.bibleinayear.org) that contains your daily reading or links you to a website where you can read assigned scriptures from your computer or smart phone.

The church leadership is challenging everyone at Second to make a goal to read through the Bible in 2010. To help with this, we are providing two Bible reading plans for you to choose from. One plan is the entire Bible in a year and the other is the New Testament in a year. These Bible reading plans will be available toward the end of December and first of January and will easily fit inside most Bibles. One of the advantages of using these plans is that the congregation will be doing it together. You don't have to use these specific plans but I do strongly encourage you to set a goal and use some plan. The bottom line – we want everyone in the Word!

Atlanta is a large, progressive city with an interesting history, but while the big city offers plenty of fun and excitement, there are socioeconomic concerns as well. Twenty-four percent of the residents live in poverty. On an average night, Atlanta's homeless population is estimated to be 11,000, with 65 percent of them women and children! Atlanta is the city with the highest rate of child poverty in the United States (48.1%). Local social service organizations, however, offer several opportunities to partner for change. This summer we want to join with these organizations to make a difference in this community.
