## A Note From Drew...

resolutions for the new year, or if you are asking God to help you with some changes, I pray you will follow through with your decision.

One of the areas that is so vital is our involvement with God's spiritual family, the Church. That is why on January 16<sup>th</sup> we are having **Back to Church Sunday**. The purpose of this special day is to invite everyone we can who does not attend worship someplace to get started.

If you skip school, it is called truancy; if you walk out on your family, it is called desertion or abandonment; if you skip your duty in the military, it is called being AWOL; if you fail to show up for work, it is called being fired. If you fail to attend worship here at Second, it is called being missed, and we want you back. Maybe you know someone who has never attended worship, or someone who was once an active member here. Please invite them. I wonder what would happen if \_\_\_\_\_ (you put in the name) got 20 invitations to attend church on the 16<sup>th</sup>? We will try to do the best we can to invite that person. Please do your part and invite them as well.

Will you think of someone you know who is not attending worship and invite them to join you on Sunday morning, January 16<sup>th</sup>?

Thank you for your help and for your obedience to the Scripture that says, "Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another-and all the more as you see the Day approaching". (Hebrews 10:25)

Another thing I need your help on is our new church directory. I want everyone who attends here to be in the directory, so would you please take part? No excuses about you not taking good pictures, or being too busy. This is an opportunity to get to know others and to let others get to know you. We want your picture, name, address and phone number in our directory. I use the directory a lot and so do many others. It is a good tool for us as we grow in our fellowship and love. Thanks for your cooperation.

It is not too late to start a Bible reading program. We have some available for you, so please pick one up and invest some time. I promise you, it will pay great dividends in your spiritual growth.

I pray that this new year will be an exciting time of working for the Lord together in His Kingdom. May He be glorified and praised in all we do and say. Drew

# TIME IN THE WORD

## The Most Important New Year's Resolution You Will Ever Make!

January is the time many people make New Year's resolutions that are designed to enhance or improve their lives. A common New Year's resolution is to exercise more, and, because of this, memberships to health clubs increase dramatically in January. While this is good, and I would encourage everyone to take steps toward improving their physical health, physical fitness is not the most important personal improvement an individual can make. The Apostle Paul says, "train yourself to be godly. For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come" (1 Timothy 4:6). So, according to Paul, the most significant resolution anyone could make this New Year is to be godlier. But how does one become a godlier person? What can a person do to accomplish this goal? Paul said we have to train ourselves to be godly. Godly training can involve several things such as prayer, stewardship, fellowship, service, and worship. However, the most important training we can engage in to develop godly lives is spending time in the Word of God.

Two years ago our church participated in the Reveal Spiritual Life Survey. To date, 280,000 people in 1,200 churches have participated in the Reveal study. The data collected from this research clearly reveals that spending time in the Word of God is the number one influencer for developing spiritual growth – which is godliness – in a person's life. The Reveal survey showed that Second Church of Christ was below average in the area of Bible

intake. For the past two years, the leadership of Second has worked diligently at encouraging people to increase the amount of time they spend in the Word. Last year we launched a read through the Bible in a year program and offered several Bible reading plans and resources. The response was excellent. We are now at the end of last year's campaign, but we want to challenge people to sign up for another year.

Beginning in January of 2011, Second will embark on another read through the Bible campaign, and we want to challenge every person who attends Second to make a New Year's resolution to read the Bible everyday over the next twelve months. We are again providing resources that will help guide people in this endeavor. You can find these resources in a special display located in the church foyer. The church's website will also direct you to some online resources as well. Reading the Bible everyday is not an end in itself. No, the main purpose of a daily Bible reading emphasis is to help people develop the important spiritual discipline of Bible intake in order that they might train themselves toward a greater level of godliness.

In May of 2011, Second will participate in a retake of the Reveal Spiritual Life survey. Repeating the survey will give us some insight on how we as a church are doing in several spiritual areas including the area of Bible intake. I am very interested to see if we have grown in this area.

The Apostle Paul said that training ourselves to be godly brings value to all areas of our lives, for both the present life and the life to come.

If this is true – and I believe it is – then spending time in the Word can be the most significant New Year's resolution you could ever make.



## Mission trip opportunity – Ivory Coast, Africa, July 2-16, 2011

Spaces are now available to join a team from Second Church of Christ that will be going to Ivory Coast, Africa, July 2-16, 2011, for a short-term mission trip. The focus of the trip will be on three areas: dentistry, optometry, and general work projects. 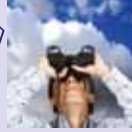

## TCM International Institute Training Christians for Ministry

TCM was established in 1957 for church planting and radio evangelism in Toronto, Canada. As a result of relationships built with Russian and Polish expatriates, TCM began to spread the Gospel behind the Iron Curtain in 1963. TCM's European base of operations, Haus Edelweiss, near Heiligenkreuz, Austria was bought in 1971. Due to the environment in which the ministry had to work, TCM provided mainly encouragement and benevolence to Russians and Eastern Europeans until 1991. In that year TCM began the Institute of Biblical Studies, now the TCM International Institute, in response to a request by Eastern Europeans wanting Christian leadership training. TCM also has twelve in-country teaching sites located throughout Eastern Europe and Central Asia. These sites provide opportunities for students to attend their courses while remaining close to their families and ministries.

### Our Mission:

to prepare men and women for Christian Leadership and provide benevolent assistance in Europe and Central Asia.

### How can you help?

Our vision is to grow to 1,200 nationals being trained by 2012 so that the kingdom of God can expand even further throughout this part of the world. Following are ministry examples of how current TCM students (764) and graduates (288) are helping to grow God's kingdom: church-planting, missionaries, church elders, bible study leaders, military chaplains, radio evangelists, teachers, bible college presidents, Christian authors, marriage counselors, translators, etc.
