A Note From Drew...

I am writing this five days before I leave for the evangelic crusades in India. I am looking forward to visiting with the Indian Christians that I worked with on three previous trips in the 90's and preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The hardest thing about the trip will be being away from my

family - both my physical family and my church family. Thank you for your prayers and support while I am gone. I will be back Saturday night, February 5th.

One of the things that makes this a little easier is the great staff, Elders, and volunteers who work so hard here at Second. One of the best compliments I can hear when I get back is that things didn't miss a beat, that attendance and offerings were up, and that everything was taken care of. We have a great staff here, and I hope you will encourage them for their extra work while I was gone.

During February we are going to be emphasizing the home and family. This is a real need because so many have come from broken, hurting homes. Many homes are in trouble and divorce has almost become an accepted part of our world. Couples are living together without being married. Many children are born to moms who struggle to raise them alone because the father is gone.

So whatever your home situation, I want to encourage you to make sure your home is Christ-centered. Single, married, with children, empty nesters - whatever the circumstance - it is when Jesus Christ is Lord that the home becomes all that it can be.

If you are having difficulty at home, please don't take that lightly. Do something before it is too late. It begins with examining our own life and asking God to transform us into the very likeness of Christ. If you are a Christian, you must live Christian at home. If there is conflict that is out of control, or if home seems more like a war zone, please begin to pray. Ask God to change the home and yield to the leading of His Holy Spirit.

We are going to be having a marriage seminar called "The Art of Marriage" on Friday and Saturday, February 25th and 26th. This is not just for people with marriage problems, but for all married people. I hope you will sign up and join me as we learn how to be better husbands and wives.

Also during Sunday morning worship we are going to be talking about checking your home insurance - not your homeowners, or house insurance, but checking to see how your home is doing. I pray that these messages will be a source of strength for all who attend, and I hope you will be here every Sunday.

I said in a message during January that having the Bible is a privilege; what you are doing with it? What we need to do is transform privilege into action. I hope you are being faithful in reading your Bible everyday.

I look forward to being back with you as we serve our wonderful Lord together. "May the Lord keep watch between you and me when we are away from each other" (Genesis 31:49-called the Mizpah benediction). **Drew**
