To the Rescue! February 9, 2014

Romans 5:6-8—“Christ died for us while we were still weak. We were living against God, but at the right time, Christ died for us. Very few people will die to save the life of someone else. Although perhaps for a good man someone might possibly die. But Christ died for us while we were still sinners. In this way God shows His great love for us.”

1 Fuel Up – Good morning and welcome to Treasure Cove! During the next few weeks we will be learning more about God’s plan of redemption for us.

In the Bible, God warns us that the wage, or result, of sin is death and that we are all sinners. It is our sin that separate us from Him. But God loves us and He doesn’t want us to remain separated from Him or pay the high price of death for our sins. God wants to redeem us; He wants to provide another way to pay for our sins and restore our relationship with Him. God’s plan of redemption is to provide us with a substitutionary atonement.

Jesus, God’s only Son, is His plan of redemption for us. Jesus was born, lived a perfect life, and died on the cross for one purpose—to pay the price for our sins. And he willingly gave up his life to redeem all of us, to pay the price for all our sins. Jesus sacrifice was preventient, it happened even before we knew how much we needed him to save us from our sins.

When we realize just how much God loves us and all that He has done, we can show Him our love by following His example and loving others, even those we don’t know or those who are not yet our friends. Then our actions will demonstrate God’s preventient plan to love and redeem us, to everyone we meet.

As a family, talk about some of the places where missionaries are still working to teach people about Jesus and decide on one area you believe God wants you to focus some prayer time. Decide how often your family will pray together for this area of the world and see if you can find a missionary in that area to pray for. You might even want to find out other ways you can support the people living there or the missionaries in that area.*
