Hebrews 11:1 – "Faith means being sure of the things we hope for. And faith means knowing that something is real even if we do not see it."

1 Casting off – Ahoy Treasure Cove families! Today we continue learning about faith and learning why we can always trust God, no matter what might be happening in our life.
