## Impact MultiCultural Ministries Becomes an Organized Church

On July 22, 2012, Impact Multicultural Ministries in Salt Lake City became a fully organized Church of the Nazarene. Since October 2009, under the oversight of the District Superintendent, Impact has been a New Start Church-type Mission led by Pastor Grantley Martelly. The weekend began on Saturday night with a concert by Caribbean recording minister, Russell Leonce, from the island of Trinidad and Tobago. On Sunday morning, Dr. Borger delivered the message of challenge and received the charter members into the church. On Sunday afternoon, Pastors and churches from twelve organizations, other denominations and foreign countries gath-



ered for worship and to bring greetings and congratulations to the newly organized Impact Multicultural Ministries. All the weekend's events were held at the church's new location at 10288 S. Jordan Gateway, South Jordan, Utah on the southern end of Salt Lake County. In its more than one hundred years in Utah, this is the first time the Church of the Nazarene has had an organized presence in this fast growing section of Salt Lake County.

Also in attendance were family members of Pastor Grantley and Tahmina Martelly from New York, Florida and the islands of Trinidad and Tobago, St. Lucia, and Barbados.

On Sunday, July 15, 105 worshippers gathered at the Nyssa Church to celebrate their 75th Anniversary! The celebration included:


- Historical Display
