1 Fuel Up –Hello Families- This week we take a break from our focus on I Corinthians 13 for Faith Promise Sunday. Today we collectively turn our attention to a very important responsibility God has given us—to tell others about His love for them.

As believers in the Lord Jesus Christ, we are privileged to have the knowledge and assurance of our salvation. Yet, there are many people living in our world who have never heard this good news or found comfort in God’s promises. And as much as we want to make certain everyone hears about Jesus, He wants them to hear the good news even more than we do!

In Matthew 28, Jesus gave directions on how we should spread his important message to others. “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.” While that seems like a big job, when we rely on the Holy Spirit we can accomplish what would be impossible without God.

On Faith Promise Sunday, we learn more about missionaries and current missions work. We also have an opportunity to participate with our brothers and sisters in The Great Commission by exercising our **faith** that God will help us give financially to support his work and making a **promise** to give money to our missionaries. As we prayerfully offer financial gifts to missions work, we can have faith that God will use these funds to spread His good news across the street and around the world.
