eXtreme Teams

eXtreme Teams are for those in 5th & 6th Grades. These teams serve on Sunday mornings during the Treasure Cove Worship hour.

Here is the purpose of each team:

Worship Team: This team is to lead the other children in worship by example and to assist the worship leader in any way possible.

Welcome Team: The Welcome team is to make every child that attends the eXtreme Faith Children's Worship feel welcome and accepted. Every eXtreme welcome Team member's goal is to seek out those that are quests and make them feel at home.
