

Nampa Christian Elementary/Middle School Dress Code

Philippians 4:5 "Let your moderation be known to all men..."

We are very thankful for the cooperation of the parents and students of NCS who work together to maintain our standards. Every parent is asked to sign a form stating they have read and agree to support the following dress code:

- Shirt logos/pictures/messages/advertisements must conform to NCS standards
- Skirt length is to be **no shorter than 2"** above the knee
- Shirts and dresses must have **at least a 2"** strap. Necklines must be modestly cut, must not be see-through or sheer, tight or clingy; must not allow undergarments to be visible
- Back and midriff must be covered at all times.
- Slacks or neat jeans--no large rips or holes, or baggy pants
- Girls wearing tights, leggings, or snug fitting knit pants/shorts will wear tops to mid-thigh or lower
- **PK-4th grade** shoes or sandals must be fastened securely around the feet; heel height must be no higher than 1" (no flip flops, clogs, platforms, etc.)
5th-8th grade may wear flip flops and clogs but may not have a heel height higher than 2"
***Tennis shoes needed for P.E. days for all grades**
- P.E. uniforms are required for 7th and 8th grade.
- Shorts allowed only in the months of August, September, October, April and May for grades PK-6. Middle school students may wear shorts any month using parent and student discretion.
 - Approved shorts for NCS students must be modest and at have at least a 6" inseam or come within 2" above the knee.
- Boys' hair must be above the eyebrows, no longer than the ear lobes on the side, and no longer than collar length in the back.
- Hair should be natural colors (Please avoid unnaturally dyed hair)
- No hats/ head coverings
- Fads will be addressed as necessary. (School policy will be adjusted as needed.)
- Not permitted: tattoos, body paint, body piercing (other than girl's ears)

Students not in accordance with dress code will be sent to the office to call home and will not be admitted back into class until appropriate clothing is brought to the school. Students with borderline infractions will be given a warning and reminded of the dress code.
