

## Nampa Christian High School Dress Code

Philippians 4:5 "Let your moderation be known to all men..."

Nampa Christian School has been established to serve families that are sincerely committed to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Dress is important to our Christian witness. The school has a responsibility toward the conscience of the Christian community as a whole, and it has some educational responsibility toward students in the matter of dress standards. To promote a Christian social atmosphere a dress code has been established. It is important that everyone attending Nampa Christian be committed to fulfilling the requirements of our dress code. Our desire is to have an environment conducive to learning and we prefer to avoid any type of attire or grooming which attracts undue attention to the wearer and distracts from the educational process. Extremes in dress, style or makeup are to be avoided as well as anything that is purposely suggestive in appeal or has the trademark of some segment of society decidedly ungodly in influence. Girls are to look feminine and boys masculine.

Clothing and jewelry worn to school cannot have negative or immoral messages, drug, alcohol or suggestive insignias or messages. This includes lyrics or persona contrary to biblical principles.

**Appearance is the responsibility of the individual student and the parents. Students who come to school without proper attention to personal grooming or appropriate dress may be asked to call their parents for a change of clothing or may, after parents have been notified, be sent home to correct these concerns. Students who violate the dress policy will remain out of class until appropriate attire is acquired. The administration reserves the right to make final decisions in regard to questionable dress or appearance.**

Nampa Christian has two separate dress codes. A general dress code and in addition, on days where there is a Chapel service, a Chapel dress code.

Some specific instructions are given below:

- Sports uniforms that do not comply with the dress code are to be worn only for designated activities.
- Hats are allowed outside of the building only.
- Earrings are permitted for girls only and are the only piercings allowed to be worn.
- Girls: Hair must be kept out of the eyes/face.
- Boys: Facial hair is not permitted. Hair should be kept out of the eyes/face and off the collar.
- Hair must be of a natural color.

We understand the above description of Nampa Christian's dress code is an abbreviated version and we agree to read and support the complete dress code as presented in the current student handbook.
