General Requirements for all NCHS students:

Note: 3 years of math and 3 years of science are required. One year of math must be in 12th grade. 4 years of math and 4 years of science is recommended.

English (4 years required)

International students entering 9th, 10th, and 11th grades can take English Lab if in their first year in the US and if their English level is not proficient. In subsequent years, students will take English at grade level.

12th grade students entering Nampa Christian as a 1st year student will take English 12. Speech will be taken separately from English.

Math (3 years required)

9th grade students will take Alg. 1 or Geometry and proceed through sequence below. 10th grade will take Geometry or Algebra II.

A math class must be taken in the 9th, 10th, and 12th grades. (All four years recommended).

Science (3 years required)

International students need to take science for three calendar years.

One of those years must be at NCHS. Biology is required.

First year International Students will take Introduction to Christianity. In subsequent years, students will be placed in Bible class by counselor.
