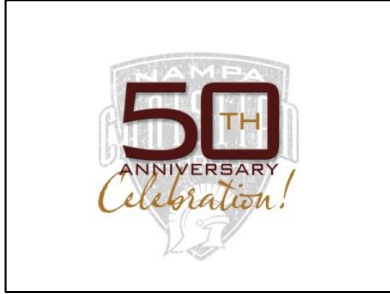


Superintendent's Newsletter

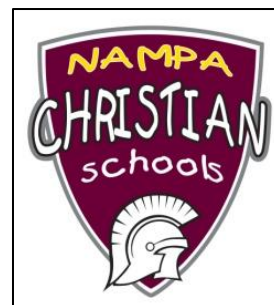

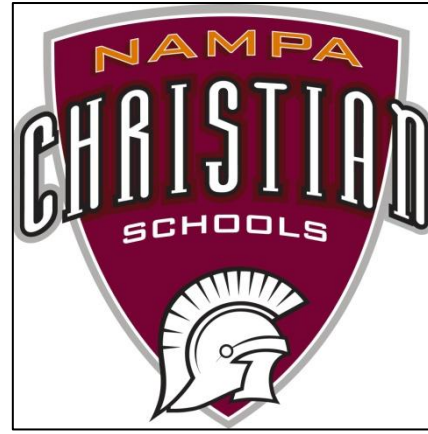
