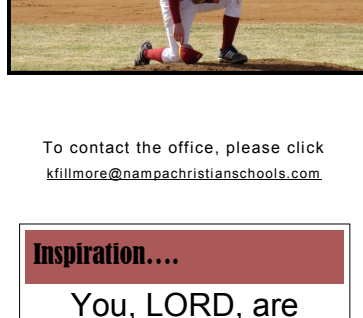

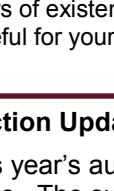

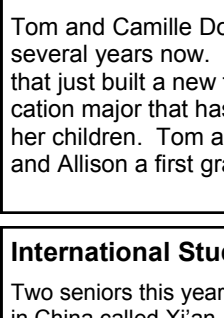

Auction Update

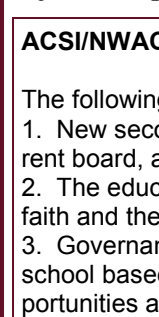
