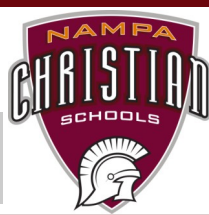

Advancing the Mission of Nampa Christian Schools

Recently Nampa Christian Schools has been through a re-accreditation process and the results of this visit were provided to constituents at the annual corporation meeting. It was a privilege to share ten updates as to how the mission of NCS can continue to be advanced because of these milestones. In case you were unable to attend the meeting, here is an executive summary of what was recently shared:

- The Biblically based character development mentoring programs in the PK-12 grades
- Football field enhancements, 20 tons of decorative rock placed in planters and painting the Orchard Campus gym
- \$1,400,000 Debt reduction includes \$600,000 balloon payment and an \$800,000 reduction in principal
- Exceptional volunteerism at NCS including Mrs. Michaelson for the distinguished service award
- Auction raised \$132,000+ in part made possible by a Chevelle donated from Todd Goode family
- 100% of NCS graduates this past year are attending college
- Fall general student enrollment climbed from 545 students in 2009-10 to 637 in 2011-12
- New Early Childhood Center under the leadership of Mrs. Asselin has 75 students
- NCS Foundation and several generous donors provided \$126,000 in financial aid to needy families
- Strategic plan was highlighted to start fundraising for phase II Flamingo campus activity spaces

In addition to the above items that advance the mission of NCS in different ways, the accreditation team that visited this spring honored NCS with the below commendations for advancing the mission:

1. New secondary school which is a monument of faith made possible by the past and current board, administration, faculty, NCS families, alumni and friends.
2. The educational statement and the correlation between vision, mission, statement of faith and the newly established core values.
3. Governance model reflecting Christ and spiritual leadership based on values of Academic Excellence, Biblical Integration, Co-curricular Opportunities and distinctive Church-Family-School Partnership.
4. Use of the strategic plan as a tool to direct and prioritize school spending, complimenting the Board of Trustees on creating a stronger fiscal position.
5. Utilizing 90+ volunteers at the elementary school to support the effectiveness of school faculty.
6. Providing a thorough peer mentorship program at elementary level for new teachers.
7. Making Concurrent credit available for juniors and seniors at local universities.
8. Progress made by administration and faculty in development of academic curriculum guides.

All ACSI and NWAC Accreditation Standards were met within appropriate compliance. I share these celebrations with you to update you on how the mission is being advanced on a day-to-day basis. Thank you for your continued support of NCS. We value your partnership and hope you have a memorable summer with your family.

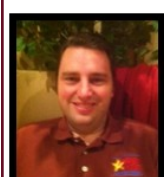
