The survey responses about attending the 2021 ATS tells us that there is more concern about finance and scheduling conflicts than COVID-19 for this summer. After much consideration and discussion, the Executive Committee agree unanimously to proceed with the ATS in Scottsdale, Arizona July 12-16, 2021. It has been a difficult decision, but we believe ICPC must move forward the best we can.

- Contactless buffet.
- Frequent cleaning by hotel staff throughout the facility.
- An ICPC app with class schedule, handouts, identification, and more.
