When do classes begin?

April 16, 2012

What are the day(s) and times of classes?

Classes are held each Monday from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and will continue for 44 weeks.

When is the last day to enroll for this year?

May 14, 2012

What is the cost to attend Bible School?

Tuition is \$525.00, Enrollment Fee: \$35.00 (Non-Refundable), \$40.00 Administrative/Material Fee, plus the cost of Text Books.

If my spouse and I want to attend Year 1, what is the cost?

If both spouses are attending Year 1, the cost of tuition is \$735.00 (a savings of \$210.00). All other fees remain the same.

What is the cost of 2nd Year?

If I enroll and decide that I do not want to remain in school, can I get a refund?

New and Living Way Bible School has a 7-day policy. After 7 days from the date of the New Student Application Form, any student who decides not to complete school for any reason may do so, however, the \$75.00 Enrollment/Administrative/Material Cost Fee will not be refunded. The first payment towards tuition is not due and payable until April 21, 2011. Therefore, no other costs would have been incurred. Unless, of course, tuition payment was made in advance, then, if within the 7 days period, the tuition amount would be refunded. There are no refunds once tuition payments start on April 21, 2012.

What if I get behind on my payments?

Any student incurring payments that are 2 months past due will not be able to attend class and receive credit until the past due balance is brought current. It is not the policy of New and Living Way Bible School to bill students for unpaid balances on their accounts. If the account is not paid as agreed in the Student Financial Agreement, and billing becomes necessary, a \$10.00 fee will be assessed to cover the cost of extra bookkeeping.

Is there an incentive to paying my student account on time?

All seminars offered by New and Living Way Bible School would be free to students who remain current on their accounts. Also, those students continuing through to 2nd Year will receive a discounted rate towards 2nd Year tuition.

What is the primary purpose of New and Living Way Bible School?

The primary purpose for the New and Living Way Bible School is to train, educate and inform believers, ministers and pastors the knowledge of God. We want them to be more equipped and become more effective in their local ministry whether that's in church or in their communities. Our purpose is also to be a resource in education for anyone who wants to go deeper in the word of God.

What are the biblical educational backgrounds for Pastors Steve and Faith Dennis?

Dr. Steve Dennis is the president of the school, with Pastor Faith Dennis being the dean. They are both 1999 graduates of RHEMA Bible Training Center, in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Pastor Steve was an instructor with the Covenant Theological Seminary for three years. In 2006, a satellite Bible school under Ministry International Institute (MII) began at New and Living Way Bible Church. MII has been successful and a benefit to Northwest Georgia's community of churches and pastors. Thus, New and Living Way Bible School was born.

Why was New and Living Way Bible School started?

"The New and Living Way Bible School was born out of the desire to formulate a school that mirrors who we are as pastors" says Dr. Steve Dennis. "Practical biblical knowledge and experience with the love for ministry is our motivation for this school. We want to give our students an opportunity for advancement and have more of an academic component in the curriculum."

What is unique about the New and Living Way Bible School?

The school incorporates an individual practicum for the student to be of service in their local church and community. The practicum sets the stage for growth of the individual student. We are a "hands on" school in which the student gets to experience and acknowledge their own personal growth in their homes, work and church. The fact that every student learns how and why to commune with God is liberating. They are literally taught four keys on how to hear from God. It's practical, easy and unique.

What would the students enjoy most about New and Living Way Bible School?

Students are excited about their own personal growth and knowledge-base in the word of God. Actually understanding where they began and envisioning where they are going is amazing. They exude confidence in their deeper understanding of God and the love of God. Every class begins with praise and worship and prayer where the students get to empty their minds and lay out all of life's challenges and the week's expectations of them. It's just them in the presence of God. For that period of time, we get

to see ourselves as He sees us. That sets the foundation for our studies, the students really enjoy that time in the presence of God.

The New Student Application Form asks that I check either a Lifelong Learner, Certificate Program, or Diploma Program. What is the difference in these three?

The Certificate Program is a one year program. Upon completion of that one year, the student will receive a Certificate of Completion. The Diploma Program is a two year program. Upon successful completion of both years, student will have received transferrable hours to pursue an accredited degree in ministry. Student will also participate in a cap and gown graduation. The Lifelong Learner is for students who are not interested in credit hours for a Diploma or a Degree. Students would attend classes, but may also be interested in attending outside workshops and seminars sponsored by the school. Students are afforded a systematic, biblically-based, Spirit-anointed life-transforming experience.

Is the school accredited?

No. New and Living Way Bible School is not accredited, however, we are connected with Christian Leadership University (CLU) who is accredited through Christian Accreditation International (CAI).

Will my hours transfer?

Transfer of hours would depend on the receiving school. CLU will accept all hours received at New and Living Way Bible School. CLU's hours may not be accepted by all schools.

Do you offer a bachelors program?

Not at New and Living Way Bible School. However, CLU does have a bachelor, master and doctoral program. Once you have completed your two-year course work with New and Living Way Bible School, we can help you contact CLU.

What other areas of concentration can I pursue through Bible School?

Once completing the 2-year program with New and Living Way Bible School, one can further their ministry education in the area of Biblical Studies or the following major concentrations:

How can I get the extra hours I would need for a degree?

The student can credit by completing a "Life Experience Portfolio". The initial cost to receive a Life Experience Notebook is \$10.00 plus shipping. When you return the completed Life Experience Portfolio, CLU will evaluate it for credits and \$13.33 is charged for each credit awarded.

What do I need to bring with me the first night of class?

Each student will need to bring their completed New Student Application Form, Student Financial Agreement, and the \$35.00 Enrollment Fee and the \$40.00 Administrative/Material Costs Fee if they have not already registered for class. The 1st \$75.00 tuition payment above will be required on the first day of class. Students will also need to purchase the two textbooks to be used in the first 12 weeks coursework - - *4 Keys to Hearing God's Voice*, \$14.95 and *Dialogue with God*, \$14.95.
