

Outline of Sierra Grace Fellowship Short-Term Mission Policy

For further information and clarification, please read the complete Short-Term Mission Statement of Policies and Guidelines.

The goal of the Missions Committee is to encourage each individual at Sierra Grace Fellowship to ask the question; “How does my life fit into God’s worldwide activity?”—and be moved to get involved. I Chronicles 16:24 “Declare the Lord among the nations, His marvelous deeds among all peoples.”

Essentials for Short-Term Missions

1. The Short-Term Mission Participant (STMP) exhibits a Christ-like character and a strong desire to serve.
2. The sending organization must be one that agrees with SGF’s theological doctrine.
3. The ministry with which the STMP will serve should be working with national workers and have a strong emphasis on evangelism.
4. The ministry should be seeking to reach unreached people groups and/or closed countries.
5. The Short-Term Mission Participant should be from our congregation.

Purposes and Goals of Short-Term Missions

1. Go where God is already working through missionaries supported by SGF and be a means of encouraging and assisting those Long-Term Missionaries (LTM). The short-term mission trip should be promoted by the vision of the SGF LTM.
2. Assist and encourage strategic partnerships SGF has or may establish, with the intention of developing or improving cross-cultural long-term relationships.
3. Be a discipleship-training tool of SGF for individuals in the body who want to integrate their faith with works.
4. Be a means of exposing and developing individuals for long-term involvement in ministry and missions.

Preparation:

1. In order to better prepare for your short-term mission trip, we encourage all STMP to read Serving with Eyes Wide Open by David Livermore. Other suggested reading: Ministering Cross-Culturally by Lingenfelter and Mayers, Short Term Missions by Mack and Leann Stiles, and Revolution in World Missions by K P Yohannan.

Follow-up:

1. A written summary of your STM experience using the Personal Reflection Questions in the STM Policy (1 to 3 pages) should be submitted to the Missions Committee upon return.
2. A 10 to 15 minute report of your missionary experience should be given upon return to the Missions Committee.

Suggested Minimum Length of Service

1. Canada, U.S.A., Mexico, and Central America – two weeks
2. Europe – three weeks
3. South America, Asia, and Africa – four weeks

Funding and Support Options:

1. We encourage the STMP to pay for as much of the trip as possible (transportation and all other mission costs).
2. Individuals should pay at least 25% of the cost from personal resources.
3. Help is available to present STM trip before the congregation. The SGF Missions Committee may provide a cover letter to accompany a letter written by the STMP explaining the trip and the specific needs.
4. We encourage the STMP to ask the congregation for ministry needs, such as: medical supplies, educational supplies, clothes and blankets, etc. to involve others in God's work.
5. Financial aid may be available from the SGF Mission Fund for those having difficulty raising their budgeted amount, but should be the last option and the final money into the account.
6. Funds raised above trip needs may go to program or material costs of the mission trip or will become part of the SGF Mission Fund.

How to apply for support from the Missions Committee:

1. First determine the level and type of support you are requesting:
 - a. A cover letter from the Missions Committee to send with a personal letter requesting prayer and financial support from the congregation
 - b. A cover letter from the Missions Committee to send with a personal letter requesting supplies for ministry needs of short-term mission trip
 - c. An account opened with SGF where tax deductible contributions can be received from friends, family, and others
 - d. A request for financial aid from the SGF Mission Fund to cover the costs of the trip not covered by donations or personal contributions (This is the last option for funding after all others have been exhausted.)
2. Then fill out the Short-Term Mission Application, being sure to indicate the support you are requesting.
3. Please submit the application at least three months prior to departure date.
4. If, after attempting to raise the necessary funds for the short-term mission trip, you find you have a short-fall, please fill out and submit the Request for Financial Aid form. (Forms are available on the SGF website or in the church office.)
5. If you have a financial deadline, be sure to submit the Request for Financial Aid form at least two weeks prior to the deadline.
