While you're there, take in the Saturday Market and/or lunch from one of the numerous food carts.

A favorite of Paul and Ann Norman: "A date we like is called the 4T Trail because it involves using the tram (Portland Aerial Tram), train (MAX), trolley (Portland Street Car) and trails. The hiking section of the trail is about 4.5 miles, unless using an optional shortcut that bypasses forest trails in favor of city streets. The trail part starts at the zoo, then heads to council crest via the Marquam trail, and over to OHSU and ride the aerial tram (no cost for going downhill) to the trolley and ride the trolley to a connection with MAX and ride it back to the zoo. You can get a map of the trail just by doing a Google Search on 'Portland 4T trail'".
