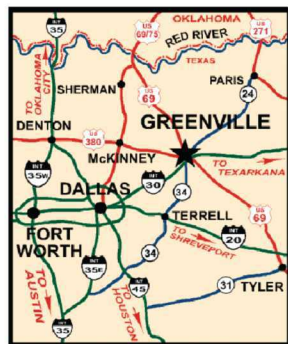

**This release form is a contract with legal consequences. Read it carefully before signing.** In consideration of the acceptance of my application for entry in the Cotton Patch Challenge, I hereby freely agree to make the following contractual representations and agreements. I fully realize the danger of participating in a bicycle ride or race and will assume the risks associated with such participation including, by way of example, and not limited to, the following: danger of collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders and fixed or moving objects; the dangers arising from surface hazards and weather conditions; the danger of cycling on highly traveled roads and highways where vehicles travel at a high rate of speed; the failure to keep proper lookout, and the possibility of serious physical and/or mental trauma or injury associated with athletic cycling events. I hereby waive, release and discharge for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assigns and successors in interest (hereinafter collectively "successors") any and all rights and claims which I have or which may hereafter accrue to me against the sponsor(s) of this event, the Greenville YMCA and the Greenville Rotary Club, its members, officers and agents, the promoter, Greenville Area Social Pedalists, its members, Texas Farm Bureau Insurance Companies, its officers or employees, proper owners, law enforcement agencies and all public entities through or by which the events will be held for any and all damages which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly in connection with or arising out of my participation in or association with the event, or travel to and return from the events. I agree it is my sole responsibility to be familiar with the course, the rules, and any special regulations for the event. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the ride or race which may be beyond the immediate control of the ride or race officials or organizers and I must continually ride so as to neither damage myself or others. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my equipment. I have no physical or medical condition which to my knowledge would endanger myself or others or would interfere with my ability to participate in this event. I further agree that if I choose to participate in this ride and not wear an approved helmet I can be subject to serious head injury and assume all liability and responsibility for injuries arising from failure to do so. I agree, myself, my heirs, administrators, legal representatives and successors and assigns, that the above representatives are contractually binding and are not mere recitals, and that should I or my successors assert my claim in contravention of this agreement, I or my successors shall be liable for all expenses (including legal fees) incurred by the other party or parties in defending, unless the party or parties are fully adjudged liable on such claim for willful or want on negligence. This agreement may not be modified orally, and a waiver of any provisions shall not be construed as a modification of any provision herein or as a consent to any subsequent waiver or modification. I also grant full permission to any and all sponsors to use photographs, photography and records of this event for any purpose.

Each tour participant entry will receive an event t-shirt, one wrist band for complimentary cup of beer, raffle ticket for a bicycle, PowerBar product and a ride number.

Covered parking is available at the Paul Mathews Exchange Building opposite the SW corner of the courthouse.

However, you must first remove your bike if it is on top of your vehicle. There is an abundance of additional parking downtown that you will be directed to after about 6:00 am.

## Routes & Rules

All tours start promptly at 9 am at the Courthouse square. The ride will be held RAIN or SHINE. There will be no refunds.

There are 5 Tour Routes from 21-65 miles. The 100K Tour includes the Legendary Leonard Leviathans (Huge Hills!). Helmets and ride numbers are required.

Riders under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

No late starts after 9:30 am. Ride at your own pace, but remember all courses and rider services close at 3 pm.

This year we will have start and finish arches marking the beginning and end of the courses. Volunteers and music will be welcoming the riders as they finish their routes.

## Road Assistance & Rest Stops

Corner Marshalls with color-coded flags man the major turns. Visible SAG teams and area bicycle shops provide mechanical support.

There are rest stops every 8-12 miles with a large assortment of fresh fruits, sports drinks and cookies. Port-a-potties are also available at the start, finish and on the course.

## After the Ride

At the end of the ride, there will be showers, soap and towels available courtesy of Texas Baptist Men.

Complimentary fruit smoothies will be served after the ride at the Landon Winery's new 10,000 sq ft facility in downtown Greenville. In addition to their extensive dining area they have a large reception room in the rear of the facility with a 2,500 sq ft outdoor covered patio. There will be a large variety of vendors present at the adjacent Rally Round Greenville festival. Massage therapists will be available under the Landon Winery covered patio after the ride.
