

THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

When faced with difficulties in life, it is good to know you can depend on the Lord. It is imperative that we remember that God keeps His promises. What He says He will do, will be done. It does not matter how dark the night, or how impossible deliverance may seem, God is able. God is a keeper of His word. He preserves its value by making sure that all of His promises to you come true. There must be value in the truth for us to believe it. This emboldens our faith in God during those times where seeing is not possible, but faith is called into action. Imagine if you lived during the times of Christ, and saw all of those miracles take place. We all need reminders that everything is going to be okay. We all want to know that God is there making everything work behind the scenes, and that Jesus is at the right hand of the Father interceding on our behalf. What we cannot see taking place on our behalf in heaven, volumetrically surpasses the struggles we face daily. That is why God left His promises for us to take hold of to remember. The Word is full of examples in the Old and New Testament, describing God's victories again and again on behalf of His people. Numbers 23:19, NLT reminds us, "God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so he does not change his mind. Has he ever spoken and failed to act? Has he ever promised and not carried it through?" You can make it through whatever it is you are experiencing, because God will keep His promises to you. There is a caveat to all of this though, you have to read the Word of God, to know the promises of God to you. Then you will be able to boldly call on those promises, and speak the truth of victory, in spite of what things may look like right now.
