THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke them. Then he gave them to the disciples to distribute to the people. They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over." Luke 9:14-17, NIV When the Lord is on your side, He is a multiplier, a miracle worker and Savior. Forget about the basic math and trying to solve problems your way. It will never work. Leave it to Jesus!


