#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Plan to join us this week on Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. for the Lenten Service, sponsored by the Durham County Missionary Union. I will share a sermonette from the fourth saying of Jesus on The Cross. On Wednesday night a Special Bible Study-Music Ministry Presentation will occur that promises to be exciting and enriching. It will feature Hymns, Praise Songs and Traditional Gospel Music. Also this week, our Music Workshop will occur on Thursday and Friday at 7:00 p.m. and Saturday at 9:30 a.m. The Workshop Concert is on next Sunday at 4:00 p.m. It will be a week of Preparation & Praise at First Calvary! Don't miss it!!

Next Sunday, March 26th, is Sacrificial Sunday. Yes, it's time again to contribute \$150.00 above your Tithes & Offerings. We are looking forward to God's blessings as we worship and give as a united Body of Faith. Stewardship, our emphasis this month, is multidimensional. We must therefore remember the key principles that WE MUST GIVE and that GIVING IS A WAY OF HAVING A PURPOSEFUL LIFE. This week you will be sent a letter to help you better understand our fiscal responsibilities and financial needs within this congregation. You will also receive our last quarter of 2016 Income Comparison Sheet, which was not available for distribution at our January Church Conference. You will also see a diagram which shows how resources are used. Some years ago, Pastor J. Alfred Smith, of Oakland, CA wrote these words which are still true today, "Giving to the giving God is not a feeling of obligation or the fulfillment of duty. It is not an effort to impress God or to bribe or to court God's favor. Our giving is our tangible act of love and adoration to God. It is our way of saying yes to God's love and to say, Thanks!" (Giving to a Giving God, PNBC Press, 1992). Giving is a great paradox, for those who believe that they don't have it to give, give it anyhow and trust God to take what you believe you don't have to give bring an unimaginable increase! Robert Morris, says, "when we give without thought to whether or not we will receive, then we receive (good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over.... Luke 6:38). In other words, when our motive for giving is right, God will reward us for giving.

I discovered something lately about First Calvary that I need to share. It seems that those who read this message each week...and the bulletin in general....are those who are giving. Those who are not giving are the ones who are not in worship, so that means I need to mail a letter to those 386 other individuals who are still on our roll but are not sharing in our great fiscal responsibility. Again I am must repeat it's not about Equal Giving but about Equal Sacrifice! Not going to be here next Sunday? You can certainly give your sacrificial offering today... or give online...or via "snail" mail... or bring it by the church office this week.

Allow me to share why we need to be accountable about our GIVING of time, talents and treasure. First, it is being true to who you are as a believer. All believers should be CHEERFUL GIVERS. Second, all believers should be CONSISTENT GIVERS. Finally, all believers are to be CHANNELING GIVERS. By this I mean that your giving should be a vehicle by which God gives back to you....read Luke 6:38. Every disciple of Jesus Christ at First Calvary Baptist Church is able to give of your TIME, TALENTS AND TREASURES according to God's Word. As we move forward in "Developing and Leading Disciples Into Spiritual Excellence", we need you to be a Cheerful, Consistent, and Channeling Giver! God has been too good not to be obedient! Don't forget Bible Study, Sunday School and the other Discipleship Study areas that we offer here at First Calvary. There is something for EVERYONE....including YOU! We can do all we do because we are AN EXCITING CHURCH EXCITED ABOUT ITS MISSION!

## THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

"Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me.... John 14:1, NLT Jesus spoke these words to the disciples as they stared in disbelief at the thought of one of them betraying Jesus, and Jesus leaving them. Where would they go without someone to lead? Do you feel as if you have been abandoned? Everything seemed to be going pretty well, and then, all of sudden, the crack in the ground turned into a crater. You thought you were following Jesus, but you lost Him in the crowd somehow. Has He left you behind? No. Jesus knows where you are and what you are going through. God does not want us to have troubled hearts. Yes, He knows that we will find ourselves in unsettling situations, moments of despair, and bewildering bouts of uncertainty. They are all part of the journey. However, troubled hearts only appear when their chambers have been pumping doubt instead of trust. There was no one greater than God, no one greater than God's son, except God Himself. We can trust God! If you find yourself in a sticky situation, trust God. Remember, nothing clogs up the chambers of our hearts quicker than doubt. Do yourself a favor. Before spiritual bypass surgery becomes necessary, take Jesus at His word-Jesus says, just trust me.


