In the case of a will, it is necessary to prove the death of the one whom made it, because a will is in force on when somebody has died; it never takes effect while the one who made it is living." There you have it. Jesus died for you! Have you claimed your inheritance?

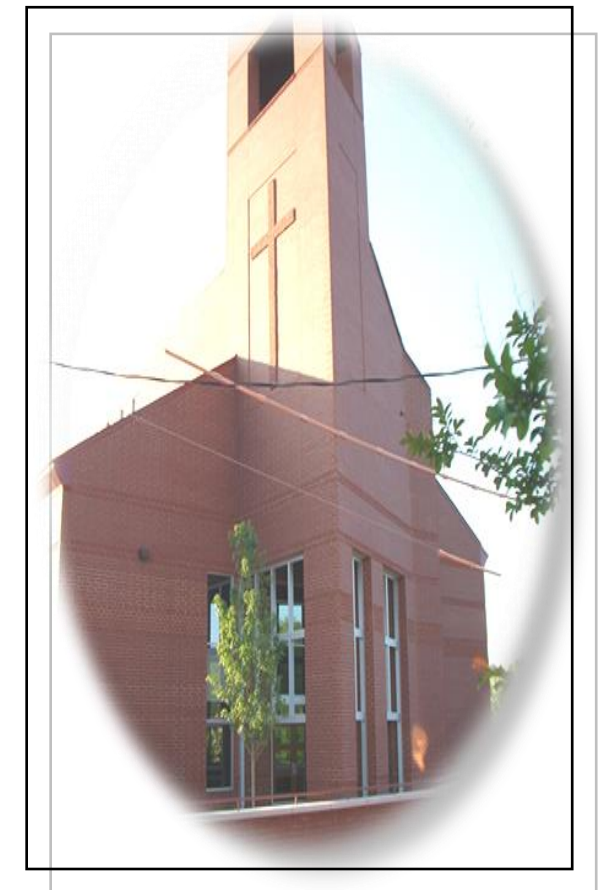
