FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

gather on this second Sunday in May, let me say that we are blessed to celebrate this day set aside to honor mothers and we wish you a Happy Mother's Day! May the guidance of the Divine lead you daily. Mothers are truly precious. Psalm 26:3 states: "For your steadfast love is before my eyes,

and I walk in faithfulness to you". Although this passage speaks of God's steadfast love being in front of us and how it causes us to walk in faithfulness to the Lord, I see a parallel to motherhood. Whenever a child looks into the eyes of a mother, that child should be able to see an unconditional, steadfast love that anchors their life and draws them towards our Christ. Mothers, Grandmothers, God-mothers, my prayer for you today is for your life to be engulfed with those kinds of eyes...the kind that draw you to a nurturing love that is like that of God's unwavering faithfulness. I remind all mothers to spend this day honoring God and giving Him the Glory! I also extend a special encouragement to those of us who have lost our mothers: may their memories be our strength each day. Again, HAPPY "BE SPOILED DAY" TO ALL MOTHERS! Celebrate the mothers and the mother figures in your life today...and everyday.

May is moving right along and so is Evangelism Month! I am reminded of the importance of the Great Commission as we celebrate this month. Jesus has commissioned us to go and make disciples. The Late Dr. Emmanuel Scott once said this about Evangelism: "The Church cannot put evangelism on the back burner without getting burned." (<u>Demythologizing The Black Church</u>, rec. by Fred Fairley). The task of the church, says Ivan Illich, "is not to socialize, but to evangelize." (An Evangelistic Lifestyle, p. 27). The question is, "Will we obey?" As Minister Carter preached some time ago, "Witnessing is Not an Option". Remember, First Calvary, that we are an evangelizing church AND a witnessing church, so just because Revival is over don't stop sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We absolutely are AN EXCITING CHURCH EXCITED ABOUT ITS MISSION!

THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

We should never forget how important it is to share the Word of God with others. You never know how great an impact it can make in someone's life. When we heed the call of the Holy Spirit and act upon what we are told to do, great things happen. In Acts 8:26-40, NIV, Philip is instructed by an angel of the Lord to, "Go south to the road—the desert road—that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." Philip follows instructions and finds an opportunity to evangelize to an Ethiopian eunuch. ..."This man had gone to Jerusalem to worship, and on his way home was sitting in his chariot reading the Book of Isaiah the prophet. The Spirit told Philip, 'Go to that chariot and stay near it.' Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading the Isaiah the prophet. 'Do you understand what you are reading?' Philip asked. 'How can I,' he said, 'unless someone explains it to me?' So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him." Acts 8:27-31, NIV How does the story end? The man asks to be baptized. Philip honored that request when they came to some water. Never doubt the importance of sharing God's Word with someone else.
