

### THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

During his Sermon on the Mount, Christ tells us about the path to eternal life in Matthew 7:13-14, NKJV. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it. The path is fraught with thistles and thorns; but it has an unrivaled rugged beauty all its own. It is a landscape worth traveling, once we accept in faith, difficulty is part of the journey. The pressures of life caused by traveling the narrow path may make us feel uneasy; but the path to eternal life was never meant to feel like a walk in the park.
