FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In Chapter XIII of the autobiography of Benjamin E. Mays, **Born to Rebel**, he writes of a personal encounter with Mr. John Hervey Wheeler. The narrative speaks of how Mr. Wheeler, attorney, business man, civil rights activist, and then president of the historic Mechanics and Farmers Bank traveled from Durham to DC to discuss the possibility of Mr. Mays becoming the next president of Morehouse College. It was early 1940, Mr. Benjamin E. Mays contemplated, for three weeks, as to what to do next. And on the conclusion of that three weeks, Mr. Benjamin E. Mays decided to **Rise Up!** ...to Shine for his light had come, and the glory of the LORD was about to do a new thing.

The children and youth of First Calvary Baptist Church are a blessed generation. Residents of a city, engulfed in African American historical prestige. Descendants of persons who persevered to heights unimaginable by some, but destined by Christ. Our Children and Youth Ministry aspires to instill in these young people a sense of spiritual excellence, responsibility, a sense of drive, and determination, and a sense of dignity and self -worth. It has been our desire this Month to celebrate our young people and give them opportunities to "Rise Up"!...and Shine. What better place to witness the gifts and spiritual talents, than our annual **Youth Showcase.** Come and enjoy praise and worship, **today at 4:00pm** as our young people offer up songs of thanksgiving, dances of jubilation, and spoken word from the heart.

The second week of June we were honored to partner with the North Carolina State MLK Commission as we hosted the Content of Character Youth Workshop. Our young people joined approximately 100 young people from throughout the state of North Carolina. The workshops discussed: Does the Music of Today build character and How Academics and Sports supports ones Character. As the month progressed, we then kicked-off our annual Vacation Bible Study, with "The Faith Run- On Course with God". On last Wednesday, we greeted our youth for our Summer Reading **Program.** This session the summer reading selection is *Brown* Girl Dreaming by Jacqueline Woodson and Crossover by Kwame Alexander. On yesterday our children shined their light, offering their services at the **Durham Food Bank**, giving back to community. Exemplifying Isaiah 58:10 where it states: "Feed the hungry and help those in need, then your light will shine out from the darkness....." At the same time, our teens participated in Discerning Your Destiny- What's in a Career? This was an opportunity to discuss and learn from African Americans in various career fields and get some hands on experience. We concluded our day with Food, Fun, and Fellowship at the Galaxy Fun Park in Raleigh.

We say thank you to those volunteers who planned and served our youth. We also say thank you to the parents of First Calvary Baptist Church for your support of our ministry efforts and for ensuring your child's presence throughout the month. Remember always that we are AN EXCITING CHURCH EXCITED ABOUTS ITS MISSION.
