FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

We also look forward to making history as a church when we worship at Duke Chapel on July 30th during our 10:45 a.m. service with the Duke Chapel Congregation. (More to be shared later!)

As we move forward in Men's Month, I will once again highlight a man from the Bible for these next few Sundays. We first started this in 2013 and we are here again in 2017. Speaking of firsts, let's talk about the first man, Adam. Adam....God's first son. He often gets a bad rap, 'cause he fell to temptation, but Adam was a man who had it all! He was allowed to commune with the very Heavenly Father that created him. He was the first head of a household, so to speak. THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

I John 2:15-17, NLT clearly explains to us what will happen if we lose our focus. And this world is fading away, along with everything that people crave. But anyone who does what pleases God will live forever." 
