I would like to give a special shout out to our Male Summit Ministry Leadership for another great Manhood Month. Thank you First Calvary for your support throughout July. We invite all men to join us for fellowship and study each third Tuesday at 7:00 p.m. Also, don't forget to pray with us each Wednesday morning at 7:00 a.m. via conference call. Also, I challenge each man and woman in this church to join us at 12:00 p. m. each Wednesday afternoon in the church's Library for noon day prayer. One day a week, spend your lunch hour with the Lord! And of course, there is Sunday School and Wednesday Bible Study. There are so many opportunities for Spiritual development, prayer and growth each week at First Calvary. Be sure YOU are taking advantage of what we have to offer!


