FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Also, on next Sunday, we will host Johnson C. Smith University Alumni's Annual Concert. Our Mass Choir will be included on the program. Please plan to be here. We will close out this month with a "special Bible Study session" on August 30th (6:30 p.m.) Come out and let's show our Appreciation for our Congregational Care Specialist, Sister Mary Gilmer, who will be celebrated by the church with a Special Thank You and Appreciation Event.
