to share with us. We experienced such an edifying time during our Annual Leadership Retreat on yesterday and we thank the Visionary Ministry for such a well-organized event. Colossians 3:17 in The Message states: **“Let every detail in your lives—words, actions, whatever—be done in the name of the Master, Jesus, thanking God the Father every step of the way.”** Thank you, Church Leaders, for your sacrifice and your service. Let's keep doing what is God's Will.

Have you heard? Our Wednesday Night Bible Study is very interesting....and it's poppin'! So join us on Wednesdays as we continue our study of God's Word.
