THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

I will call on the LORD, who is worthy of praise, for he saves me from my enemies. They attacked me when I was weakest, but the LORD upheld me. He led me to a place of safety; he rescued me because he delights in me. The LORD rewarded me for doing right; he compensated me because of my innocence. Psalm 18:3, 18-20, NLT Prayer to God makes all the difference. If you want victory in your battles, prayer to God is your weapon of choice. When we get overwhelmed, exhausted, and simply tired of trying, we still must pray. Even in our weakest moments, God hears our whisper-like uttering of hope and trust in Him. God knows you are tired, but you have to hang in there until the work He has called you to do is done. When you are thinking retreat, God is thinking rescue. There is a big difference between the two. You retreat after defeat or when defeat is imminent. Rescue happens when one is in danger or harm's way. God wants you to complete His work, so He will rescue you at the right time. Since you are on God's team you cannot be defeated, so retreating is not an option. This means that even though you may get weary in the battle, you must persevere. Remember, you should never be too weak to pray to God for help when you need it.
